REPORT OF COMMITTEE ON GENERAL EDUCATION.

Your Committee on General Education have pleasure in submitting the following report:—

1. We rejoice at the continued prosperity and spirit of advancement in our various connexional institutions of learning, which are proving so mighty in the diffusing of the knowledge and culture of to-day. We are especially pleased that the general work and teachings of our institutions are so strongly permeated with Christian truth. Our power as a Church to lift the masses nearer to God is greatly increased.

2. We strongly recommend that our Financial District Meetings take such action as shall ensure more marked success at the annual educational meetings held on Circuits. We believe that the active sympathies of the people should be more fully enlisted in the great problem of education. It is imperative to take such action, in order to keep our educational work fully abreast of the times.

3. We desire to emphasize the fact that it is the duty of all our people to stand loyally by all our colleges, whether—ladies' or otherwise—in the matter of sending their young people to our own centres of learning, that they may be saved to Methodism.

4. We regret to learn that in many instances our ministers are not embracing the opportunities which our school system of Ontario affords them of visiting our public and high schools. We believe such visitation would tend to the closer union of secular and religious instruction.

5. We would recommend that Rev. E. N. Baker, M.A., B.D., be representative to Alma College, and Revs. S. J. Shorey and T. W. Jolliffe be representatives to Albert College from this Conference.
