Payments should be made in two instalments, and strictly in advance; the first at the opening of the scholastic year, and the second at the beginning of February. No deduction will be made for an absence of less than thirty consecutive days for boarders and two consecutive months for outside boarders.

Interest will be exacted for all arrears.

Sick scholars are intrusted to the care of the Sisters of Holy Cross Hospital, at the expense of the parents.

None but relations or those who represent them are allowed to visit the pupils.

Text-books are sold by the Institution.

Every student must wear the customary uniform, consisting of a black frock coat with white seams, a blue sash and a black military cap.

Every new student must present on his arrival, a certificate of good character, either from his parish priest, or, if he comes from another institution, from the president thereof.

During the scholastic year of about ten months parents will receive three reports of their children's progress and deportment.

All idle, pernicious or insubordinate students will be dismissed.
