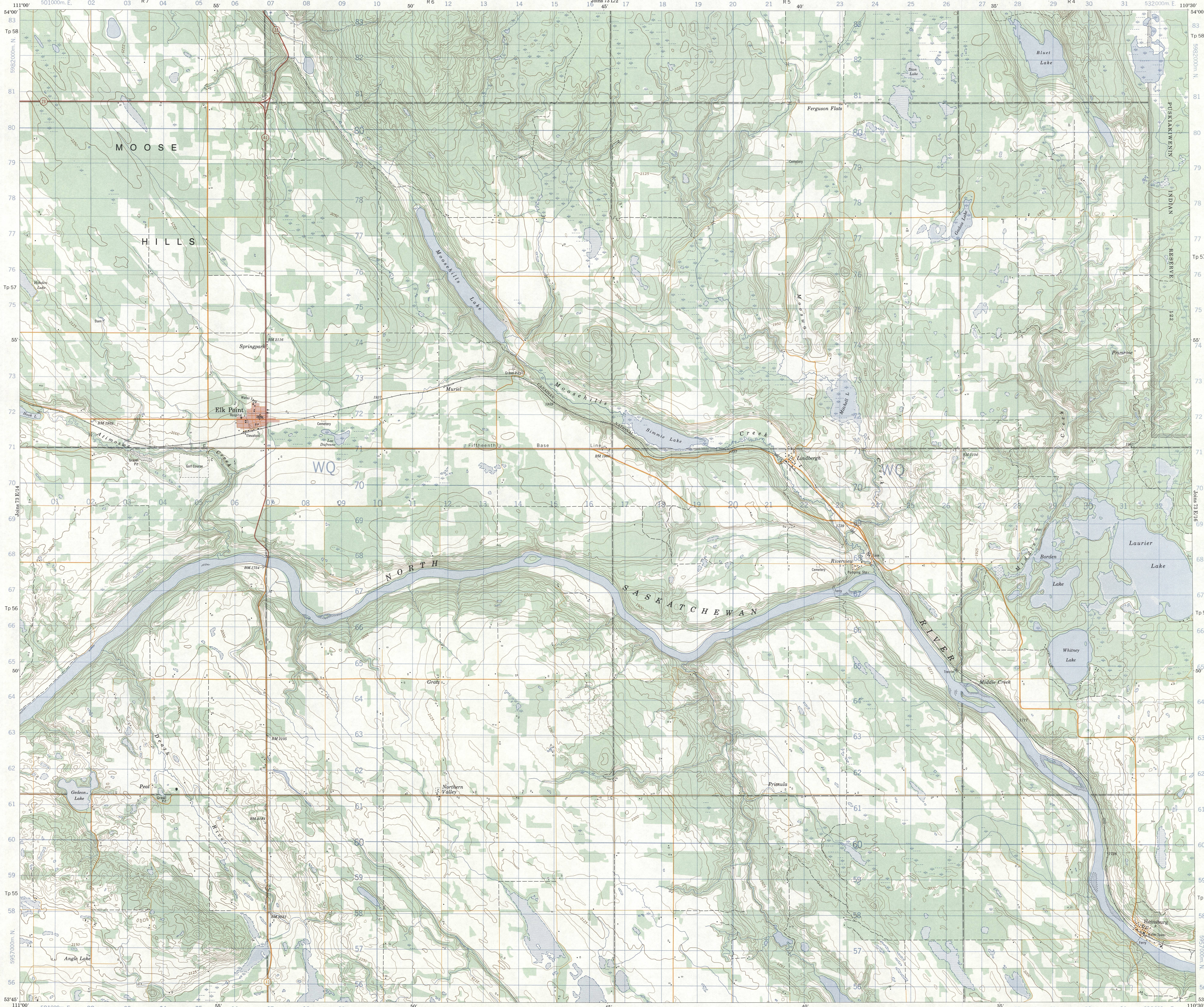
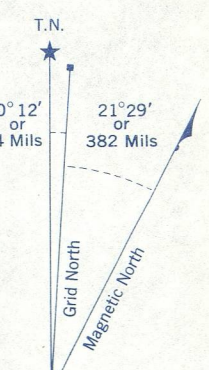


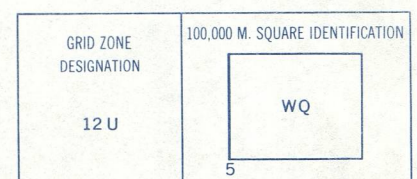

EXAMPLE OF METHOD USED
TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES
THE FOLLOWING GRID REFERENCE IS SHOWN ON THIS MAP
AND GIVES THE AREA 100 METRES ON THIS MAP

REFERENCE POINT	CHURCH (see above)
EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point	97
Estimate tenths of a square from this line eastward to point	97.5
NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point	98
Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point	98.2
