ROYAL ASSENT

The Honourable Robert Taschereau, P.C., Chief Justice of Canada, Deputy of His Excellency the Governor General, having come and being seated at the foot of the Throne, and the House of Commons having been summoned and being come with their Speaker, the Honourable the Deputy of His Excellency the Governor General was pleased to give Royal Assent to the following bills:

An Act respecting General Mortgage Service Corporation of Canada.

An Act to incorporate Income Life Insurance Company of Canada.

An Act to incorporate Income Disability and Reinsurance Company of Canada.

An Act respecting Canada Health and Accident Assurance Corporation.

An Act respecting the Boundary between the Provinces of Manitoba and Saskatchewan.

An act respecting the Boundary between the Province of Saskatchewan and the Northwest Territories.

An Act to amend the Canada Lands Surveys Act.

An Act to amend the Canada Labour (Standards) Code.

An Act to incorporate Bank of British Columbia.

The Honourable Lucien Lamoureux, Speaker of the House of Commons, then addressed the Honourable the Deputy of His Excellency the Governor General as follows:

May it please Your Honour:

The Commons of Canada have voted certain supplies required to enable the Government to defray the expenses of the public service.

In the name of the Commons, I present to Your Honour the following bill:

An Act for granting to Her Majesty certain sums of money for the public service for the financial year ending the 31st March, 1967.

To which bill I humbly request Your Honour's assent.

The Honourable the Deputy of His Excellency the Governor General was pleased to give the Royal Assent to the said bill.

The House of Commons withdrew.

The Honourable the Deputy of His Excellency the Governor General was pleased to retire.

The sitting of the Senate was resumed.
