incitement of actual warfare, should be postponed until the excitement of the public mind has in some degree subsided. It is of great importance that criminals Sir J. Colborne, guilty of such an offence should not be confounded in public estimation with 19 March 1838. offenders who are chargeable with merely political offences.

In the contingency of any capital convictions taking place for political offences, you will reserve such cases for the consideration of Her Majesty's Government.
