XXX. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that if an officer, Cashier, Clerk, or servant of the said Bank, entrusted with any Bond, Obligation, Bill obligatory or of credit, or of any other Bill or Note, or any security, money, or effects belonging to the said Bank, or having any bond, obligation or bill obligatory or of credit, or any other bill or note, or any security, money or effects of any other person or persons lodged or deposited with the said Bank or with him, as an officer, cashier, clerk orservant of the said Bank, shall secrete, embezzle or run away with any such bill, bond, obligation, bill obligatory or of credit, or any such other bill or note, security, money or effects or any of them, or any part of them, every such officer, Cashier, Clerk or servant so offending, and being thereof convicted in due form of law, shall be deemed guilty of felony and shall suffer death as a felon, without benefit of Clergy.

XXXI. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that if any person or persons shall forge or counterfeit the common seal of the said Bank, or shall forge, or counterfeit or alter any bond, obligation, bill obligatory or of credit, or any other bill or note of the said Bank, or any person or persons whomsoever or shall alter or pass any forged, counterfeit or altered bond, obligation, bill obligatory or of credit; or any other bill or note of the said Bank or indersement or indersements thereon, or shall demand the money therein-nentioned and contained, knowing the same to be forged, counterfeit or altered, every such person for every such offence, upon conviction thereof in due form of law, shall be deemed and adjudged to be guilty of felony, and shall suffer death as a felon, without benefit of Clergy.

XXXII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that if any person eugrave, form, make or mend any plate or plates, paper, rolling press or other tool, instrument or material devised, adapted and designed for stamping, forging or making any false and counterfeit Bill of Exchange, Promissory Note, undertaking or order for the payment of money, purporting to be the Bill of Exchange, Promissory Note, undertaking or order of the said Bank, or of any of the officers or persons engaged in the management of the concerns of the said Bank, in the name and on the behalf of the said Bank, or shall have in his possession any such plate or plates engraven in any part, or any paper, rolling press or other tool, instrument or material devised, adapted or designed as aforesaid, with the intent to use and employ the same, or to cause or permit the same to be used and employed in forging and making any such false and counterfeit Bills of Exchange, Promissory Notes, undertakings or orders, every person so offending shall be deemed and taken to be
