Thank you to all those amazing grads who donated to the Light-a-path project. If you haven't donated yet its not too late! Drop by Room 117 of the SUB for more information.

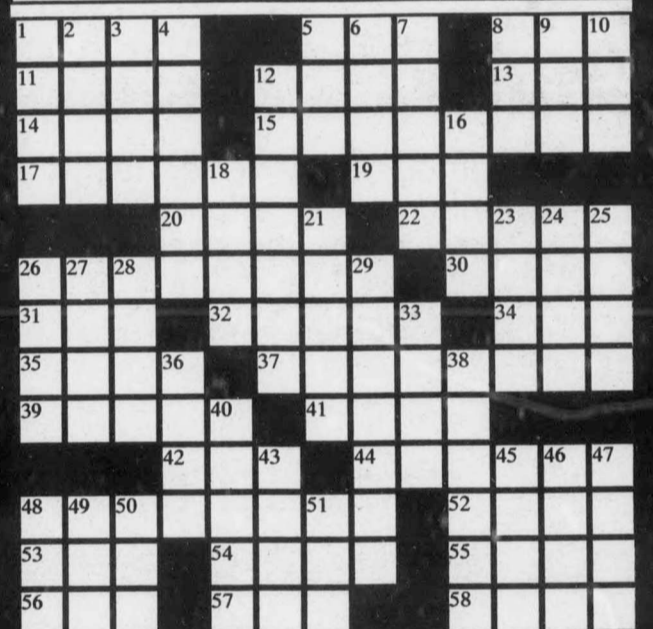
Information on graduation, tickets, formal and other grad week events will be sent to you in May.
