Reasons obscure pending investigation. Categorized probable A-.</p> <p>General flying washed in at 0800 hours with ceiling unlimited, visibility 10 miles, slight ground haze. Wind S.W. - S. Flying washed out at 1600 hours (account of Wings Parade). No night flying.</p> <p>Total flying time 216.20 hours.</p>	
	14-8-42		<p>Yale 3370 located in Georgian Bay and salvage operations begun. Pilot's body not found.</p> <p>At 1030 hours ceiling 400 feet, visibility 1 mile. Wind south, 4 - 6 m.p.h. Flying was washed in at 1330 hours with ceiling unlimited, visibility 3 - 4 miles. Night flying organized and carried out at Camp Borden until 0245 hours, when it was washed out on account of haze and slight fog.</p> <p>Total flying time 173.10 hours.</p>	
	15-8-42		<p>Course 62 consisting of 60 R.A.A.F. pupils, reported and commenced training.</p> <p>Yale 3393 nosed up on main aerodrome at Camp Borden at 1130 hours. Pilot R135060, LAC Gardiner, W.A. uninjured. Failed to correct for swing on landing. Categorized C1.</p> <p>Flying commenced at 0800 hours. Ceiling unlimited, visibility 1 mile, hazy with fog. Wind south, 10 - 12 m.p.h. No night flying carried out.</p> <p>Total flying time 164.15 hours.</p>	
	16-8-42		<p>At 1300 hours, ceiling 1500 feet, visibility 3/4 mile with ground fog and haze. Wind 12 - 14 m.p.h., S.W.-W. Flying was not washed in until 1500 hours by which time conditions were improving with ceiling 3000 feet and visibility 6 miles. Flying continued until 1730 hours. Night flying organized and carried out at Borden only.</p> <p>Total flying time 107.35 hours.</p>
