Dear Mr. Meighen:-

I am in receipt of your favor of the
10th instant.

For over three weeks the Cartier-MacDonald Club has been busy revising lists in the counties of Laurier-Outremont, St. James and St. Mary. We have willing persons who are attending to such work but it is impossible for us to make such revision of the lists without funds. I have collected a little money to make the revision of the lists in the three abovementioned counties, but the Cartier-MacDonald Club finds it impossible to make the revision of the lists in other counties on the Island of Montreal without getting any financial help.

It seems to me that the Honourable Mr. Bal-lantyne and Senator Webster should not desert us, as they have done for several months, and they ought to meet at least what they engaged themselves to pay, viz: \$3,000.00 a year to the Cartier-MacDonald Club and \$2,000.00 a year to La Minerve. In virtue of this agreement they owe me up to date the sum of \$2,500.00. I have advanced this sum out of my own money and a still larger amount and those two gentlemen, besides paying the sum of \$2,500.00, should help us for the revision of the lists, at least in the French-Canadian counties on the
