

the Acting Superintendent General of Indian Affairs to be sold to you, the Minister of Justice has decided that as to the Water lots they may be patented to you; but that in respect to the road allowance, you must apply to the Municipal Authorities of the Township of Skennington for closing and selling the same.

In these circumstances all that is competent for the Department now to do is to issue a Patent in your favour for the water lots in question and to refund you the balance of the purchase money paid by you for the road allowance, for which, as the Minister of Justice states, a Patent cannot be legally issued
