

You can explain to the
Pikevener Indians that from
the sale of lands surrendered
by the Indians who occupy
the other part of the island,
so large a sum has been
already realized that the
annual interest money derived
from it and sent up to
be divided among the Indians
amounted last year to a
sum exceeding one thousand
Dollars (\$1,000⁰⁰): that this
year it will be larger, and
for many years it will increase
more and more. You can
further inform them that the
plan adopted has been to set
apart
