Low can explain to the Wiekwernikone Indians that from the sale of lands surroudered by the Intimes who occupy the other part of the colona, so large a sum has been already realized that the annual interest money desir from it and sent up to be divided among the Indians amounted last year to a sum exceeding one thousand Dollars (\$1,000 ?): that this year it will be larger, and for many year it will increase more and more. You can further cufom them that the plan adopted has been to let apart
