With regard to the other articles mentioned in your letter I may say as follows:-

The milch cow that you have at present should be transferred to the new Agency when you remove there.

The democrat wagon now in use should also be transferred.

The cooking stove for your house and the bob sleighs for the farmers on Piapot and Pasqua Reserves may be purchased, the former when you remove to your new headquarters and the latter when required next fall.
