



Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 7th Instant, with regard to Lot 17, Quarante Arpents Reserve, and the proposal of the purchaser, Mr. Joseph Gagnon, to immediately pay the balance against this Lot, I have to inform you that the Department will accept the payment of \$326.00 Principal, and Interest on the unpaid balance of the purchase money of the land, being \$1.25, or a total of \$327.25, if paid forthwith.
