



Ottawa, 11th November, 1918.

Sir:-

In reply to your letter of the 4th instant, I beg to say that the Department received the voucher No 7037 and Voucher No 7038 which you submitted on the 20th September in favour of Dr H.J. Hassard. Both of those vouchers were made out on medical report forms and did not bear the appearance of accounts, with the result that they were filed with reports, not accounts, and consequently payment was delayed. A cheque, 3458 for \$78.00 is now going forward in settlement of both vouchers. You should supply Dr Hassard with the proper forms on which to render his accounts in future.
