


FINDING: The Court find the accused, C-49968, Pte. Murray Hamilton
Freel, No. 9 District Depot, C.A., not guilty of desertion
but guilty of absence without leave on the first charge and
not guilty of desertion but guilty of absence without leave
on the second charge and guilty of the third charge.

SENTENCE: The Court sentence the accused, C-49968, Pte. Murray Hamilton
Freel, No. 9 District Depot, C.A., to undergo detention for
one hundred and thirty days and to be put under stoppages of
pay until he has made good the sum of \$23.80 in respect of
losing by neglect his arms, clothing, equipment and regimental
necessaries.
