No.32, Bartlett Island - Clayoquot Tribe (Ahousaht Band)	172.00 "
No.33, Kut-co-us Point - Clayoquot Tribe (Ahousaht Band)	98.20 "
No.34, Hismit Fishery - Clayoquot Tribe (Manhouset Band)	8.80 "
