Reference is made to your letter of October 20th, 1944, your file No. 136-15-6627, in which you concurred in Mr. Ashbridge's recommendations as to the disposal of the band funds for bands in the Clayoquot District.

It is noted that Mr. Ashbridge has alloted reserves 1 - 29 inclusive as among the Clayoquot, Keltsomaht, Ahousaht and Manhauset Bands. We would appreciate having your recommendation as to the allotment of reserves 30 - 34 inclusive, shown in the schedule as follows:
