

V. REGULARITY OF ATTENDANCE.

To secure that regularity so highly necessary for the good government of a Lodge, it is expected that every Officer will attend punctually at the hour named for the Meetings, under penalty of censure by the Master, unless exonerated by some reasonable excuse or cause of absence.

VI. CLOTHING.

Brethren shall at all times appear, when in Lodge in the proper Masonic Clothing, as prescribed by the Book of Constitution.

VII. DISCUSSION.

Every Brother, when speaking, shall address himself to the Master; and no Brother shall speak twice to the same question, unless in explanation or the mover in reply. No Motion shall be entertained unless it be duly proposed and seconded, and shall be made in writing if any member request it. No new business shall be entered upon after eleven o'clock at night.

VIII. VISITORS.

No Visitor shall speak to any question without leave of the Master, nor shall he, on any occasion, be allowed to vote. During his continuance in the Lodge he shall be subject to its By-Laws.

IX. INITIATION AND JOINING FEES, &C.

The Fee upon Initiation shall be Twenty-five Dollars, which shall be in payment of the three Degrees in Craft Masonry, and the Grand Lodge Fees for Registration and Certificate. The fee for a joining
