Your Committee on Constitutions, to whom were referred the amended Constitution of the Grand Encampment of Utah, changing the time of meeting from the third Tuesday in April to the fourth Tuesday in October; the amended Constitution of the Grand Lodge of Washington; the Constitution and By-Laws of the Grand Encampment of *Ontario*; the Constitution, By Laws and Rules of Order of Kingfisher Lodge, No. 14, Oklahoma, under the immediate jurisdiction of the Sovereign Grand Lodge, have examined the same and recommend the following:

Resolved, That the amended Constitution of the Grand Encampment of Utah; the amended Constitution of the Grand Lodge of Washington; the Constitution and By-Laws of the Grand Encampment of *Ontario*; the Constitution, By-Laws and Rules of Order of Kingfisher Lodge, No. 14, of Oklahoma, be approved.
