One large New York producer sets up on his bench in front of his various helpers samples of different grades of honey. He takes a comb of what he considers fancy honey. He puts one such comb in front of each operator, and he says, "When you are in douot, compare it with that; when it compares dosely with that, grade it as fancy; if it does not, do not put it in the fancy grade under any consideration.
