required by this act, and the levying of the feveral fines herein before recited, shall be served and executed by a Non-comofficer. missioned Officer under the warrant of the Commanding Non-commif-' -Officer of each company; and, in case of neglect or refusal. fuch Non-commissioned Officer shall forfeit and pay a fine of twenty (hillings, to be recovered and applied as aforefaid. in all cases where there are no effects whereon to levy the several fines imposed by this act, the faid Commanding Officer is hereby impowered by his warrant to commit the person so offending to the next Gaol; there to be and remain not exceeding ten days.

Persons disabled to be provided for, at the expence of the province.

X. And be it enacted, That if any person be wounded or disabled upon any invasion, insurrection or rebellion, he shall be taken care of and provided for, at the expence of the province during the time of fuch disability.

Quakers, on producing the necessary cernificate, to be exdinary duties-

XI. Provided always, and it is enacted, That every person. professing himself to be of the people called Quakers and producing to the Captain or Commanding Officer of the company in whose district he resides, a certificate from one of their meetings, figned by fix or more of the principal people of fuch meeting, that fuch person had been deemed and allowed one of the people called Quakers, for the space of one whole year or more before the date of the certificate, such person so producing fuch certificate, shall be and hereby is exempted from the ordinary duties of training or mustering, unless upon an alarm, invasion, insurrection or rebellion.

XII. And be it enacted, That this act shall be and remain in force until the first day of March, which will be in the year of our LORD one thousand seven hundred and ninety-seven and no longer.
