as aforefaid, to amend and keep in good repair wholly at their own expence, the Roads upon the Hills and Bridges aforefaid; and that it will therefore be just and reasonable that fome aid be given towards amending and repairing the fame; Be it therefore enacted by the fame authority, that it shall and may be lawful for the Justices of the Peace, at any general Quarter Seffions of the Peace to be holden at the aforefaid Cities, respectively to order to be paid from the faid monies, which may be received by the Road Treasurers of the aforesaid Cities, respectively, under t e authority of this Act, any fum not exceeding, annually, one hundred pounds current money of this Province, to be applied under the directions of the faid Juffices, and in the manner herein provided, towards the amending and repairing the Roads upon the Hills and Bridges kept up by joint labour, in the Country Districts, respectively, as aforesaid, and in addition to the work to be done under this Act, by the Inhabitants thereof.

XIX. And whereas by the before mentioned Act, paffed in the thirty fixth year of His prefent Majefly's Reign, it is provided, that an affelsment shall be made, once, in every year, upon all and every the occupier or occupiers of Lands, Lots, Houles and Buildings, in proportion to the annual value thereof, within the Citics of Quebcc and of Montreal, to be applied towards the making amending and keeping in repair the Streets, Causeways, Pavements, Bridges, Drains, Water-courses, Sewers, Marketplaces, Squares and Lanes, within the limits of the faid Cities, wherein fuch affelsment shall be made respectively; and that the affestiment to to be made, shall not exceed the rate of four-pence in the pound of the yearly value of the Lands, Lots, Houfes and Buildings fo affeffed; And whereas experience has shewn that the rate of the aforefaid affefiment is infufficient for the faid purpoles, and that it will be expedient to augment the lame. Be it therefore enacted by the authority aforelaid, that the Affeffment authorifed by the before mentioned Act paffed in the thirty fixth year of His prefent Majefly's Reign, to be made upon all and every the Occupier or Occupiers of Lands, Lots, Houles and Boildings, within the Cities of Quebec and Montreal, respectively, may be increased to, but shall not exceed, the rate of fix-pence in the pound of the yearly value of the Lands, Lots, Houles and Buildings, to be affeffed: And the annual value of the faid Lands, Lots, Houfes and Buildings shall be estimated by the Affelfors who shall be posseful of real property in the faid Cities of Quebcc and of Montreal, respectively, once in every Year: And the faid Affeffment shall be made from the tenth day of May to the tenth day of June in each year.

XX: And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that all grounds used for Pasture, Hayland or for raising grain, without the Fortification Walls of the faid Cities, respectively, but within the Town Districts of the faid Cities, as described by the Prefent Act, shall be affeffed for the purposes herein mentioned; excepting only the grounds occupied by any of the Religious Communities of. Women.

XXI. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that from and after the first day of January, which will be in the Year of Our-Lord One thousand eight hundred, inftead of the perfonal labour required by the Act before mentioned, the proportion of Labour to be performed by every Male. Inhabitant of the. Cities of Quebec and Montreal, respectively, living within the limits described by the Proclamation herein before mentioned, of the Age of twenty one and under the age of fixty years, formed by every nerein being bona fide an Apprentice or Regular Student in the Seminaries, Colledges or Public Schools, and who shall not be liable to contribute by Affefiment to the Funds treat; who do not herein before mentioned, shall be regulated by the amount of the Assessment or rate - directed :
