thereof, on the oath of one or more credible Witness or Witnesses, before any one of Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace, of the County in which such offence hath been committed, shall forfeit and pay the sum of Five Pounds with Costs of Prosecution; one half of which sum shall be paid to any person who shall prosecute and sue for the same, and the other half into the Public Treasury of this Island, to and for the use of Her Majesty's Government.

CAP. IV.

AN ACT to revive and continue an Act, for regulating the sale of the Interest of Lease-HOLDERS when taken in Execution.

[April 25th, 1839.]

Revives and continnes Act of SG. regulating the rest of Leaseholders taken in Execution for 10 years, and from of the then next Session of the General Assembly.

HEREAS the hereinafter mentioned Act has expired, and it is deemed expedient to revive and continue the same: Be it enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That 4, continuing and amending Act of an Act passed in the Eighth Year of the Reign of 59 Geo. 3d, His late Majesty King George the Fourth intituled His late Majesty King George the Fourth, intituled An Act to continue and amend an Act passed in the Fifty-ninth Year of His late Majesty's Reign. intituled 'An Act to regulate the Sale of the thence to the end Interest of Leaseholders, when taken in Execu-'tion, be, and the same is hereby revived and continued in full force and effect, for the space of Ten years, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly.
