WEEKLY MEETING.

The weekly meeting of the Municipal Council was held yesterday afternoon at 7 o'clock in the Council Chamber. Mayor Cook presided and Council members present were Messrs. Martin, Overbridge, Vincent, Collier, Ryan and Dowden.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed, and the following business was then transacted:

Mr. A. G. Andrews, New Government Engineer, referred to damage done to property of his client on Monday 19th inst. through surface water and asking compensation; failed to be taken. This matter was referred to the City Solicitor, as also a letter from the City Solicitor, dated 12th inst., to Pleasant Street.

St. John's Light and Power Company and the Council that in accordance with the Regulations recently passed prohibiting the posting of signs and placards on electric poles within the City, they had given notice for the cleaning down of poles.

McDonald called attention to a sewer of water-course, Topwell and suggested that a large pipe should be there to carry off the sewer. This was endorsed by the Council and it was ordered accordingly.

A petition was tabled from Messrs. Ryan and Ruby, with regard to construction of street junction of Lime and George Streets, which will be in the hands of the City Engineer.

Mr. M. P. Tobin, Duckworth Street, and J. H. Thomas, Long Pond, complained of the condition of the streets in their respective localities. Inspector of Roads will be instructed to have both roads attended to.

Application of the Churchill Marine Engineering Works, for share of work in connection with the repair of the Council's trucks, etc., was ordered placed on file.

Request of Mr. R. D. Dunn, for permission to excavate and grade the fronting his residence, Park's was referred to the City Engineer.

Residents of Circular Road protested against the erection of a garage by Mr. R. Coleman. Permission was given Mr. Coleman for this structure, but under certain conditions which he has not carried out. It is therefore ordered that he be notified immediately to remove the structure.

The complaint made by Mr. John Bell, re condition of Beaumont Street, will be given attention.

Permits were granted as follows, subject to the approval of the City Engineer and conditional upon the applicants conforming to the Municipal Regulations:—F. T. Brehm, addition to garage, Forest Road; P. Casperson, Water St. West.

The City Engineer's report for week ending 19th inst. of which the following orders were made: Application of G. M. Barr for permission to water pipe premises, granted conditional upon his payment of installation; In the matter of the petition of residents of Plymouth and Quill Roads, asking the removal of the existing plant to another site, the Council is unable to accede to this request, but arrangements will be made to season to lessen the annoyance caused by dust, noise, etc.

Attention was called to the fact that the present time many houses in the city are without numbers, and the Council are being continually requested by members of the medical profession and trade generally of the inconvenience caused them in connection. The City Engineer is instructed to prepare re-arrangement of house numbering, which will be undertaken early next year.

The Medical Officer of Health reported 25 new cases of Scarlet Fever and 15 cases of Diphtheria in the city during the week. In the city at the present time there are some 118 cases of Scarlet Fever, of which there are 52 in the hospital and 64 under treatment at home.

Architect Barker reported on the state of work at the new Sanitary Sewer and submitted specification of necessary paintings of interior for which are to be called.

Reports of the Sanitary Supervisor and other officers were tabled and passed, and requisitions for payment of accounts for week were presented and paid, and there being further business, the meeting then closed.
