The special car of Wanton Stanley Webb war correspondent and oriental traveller, containing exhibits from the Hawaiin and Philippine Islands, arrived in town last night. The car is 67½ feet in length with six wheel trucks, air brakes, combination platforms and travels only on first-class trains. It was built to order for Mr. Webb and besides being admirably fitted up to show off the exhibits, is equipped with all the comforts of a home, containing buffet, kitchen, effice, bed, bath and dining room, and is a model of neatness and convenience.
