CLOUDY TO FAIR, LIGHT SNOW, COLDER.
TORONTO, Jan. 4—11 p.m.—The pressure is increasing over the Northwest, with colder weather. The low pressure over the lakes has been transferred to the Maritime Provinces, and there is now a tendency for higher pressure throughout the lake and eastern districts. The weather in the lake district has been fair and mild, but lower temperature and light local falls of snow have prevailed in Quebec. In the Maritime Provinces it is fair and showery.
Minimum and maximum temperatures: Esquimaux, 30°—36°; Calgary, 4°—8°; Battledore, 14° below—2° below; Qu'Appelle, 8° below—2° below; Winnipeg, 22° below—zero; Port Arthur, 6° below—6°; Toronto, 37°—46°; Kingston, 32°—36°; Montreal, 12°—40°; Quebec, 14°—22°; Halifax, 36°—42°.

MUSICAL AND DRAMATIC.
MANTLE SATURDAY NIGHT.
At the Grand Opera House on Saturday evening Mr. Robert Mantell will introduce for the first time to a London audience his latest play, the classic tragedy of "Parrhasius." He has produced it in the leading cities, and has everywhere scored a decided success. The recognized leading critic of San Francisco, where had acting is not tolerated, speaks thus of the production: "Evidently the most satisfactory and pleasant work, from his own view, that Robert Mantell has done during his engagement at the California, is his acting of the role of 'Parrhasius' in the tragedy of that name by Esop Williams. Mr. Mantell is by no means alone in his opinion of the new play, which is considered by many competent judges the strongest tragedy of modern times. Mr. Mantell's impersonation of the great painter borders closely upon the perfection of dramatic art. Between his first beautifully expressed adoration of his charming wife and his sedulously repressed ambition to paint the agonies of death, there is a contrast which requires the subtle touch of the true artist to harmonize; but it is in the intensely dramatic agony of the third act, when the dreadful crime that he has committed becomes known to him, that his greatest triumph occurs. At the moment when the lines the terrible torture of a broken heart, a blighted home, and the reflection that he has lost those he best loves, racks him, even as he has racked the wretched slave, without the utterance of a word the artistic force of the actor reveals itself, and the audience already wrought to a high tension of enthusiasm by the charming diction of the author, spontaneously acknowledges the irresistible power of dramatic art."
