The machine shop on the ground floor is one of the best equipped in the Province and contains, amongst others, grinding and corrugating machines, 12 lathes of all kinds and sizes, 3 drill presses, 1-60 inch radial drill, 1 planer with bed 12 feet, gap 3' x 3', 2 shapers 14 inch stroke, 1 gear cutter, 3 cranes, drills, files, taps, and dies, etc.

The erecting wood shop is in the second storey, fully equipped with saws of all kinds, wood lathes, etc.

Tin shop is in the top flat, and is well supplied with a tinsmith's outfit.

A One-Storey Wing

265 feet long x 50 feet, comprises engine room 26 x 50, blacksmith's shop 42 x 50, foundry and cupola room 83 x 50, millwright shop 51 x 50, and planing mill 61 x 50. All these departments are thoroughly equipped, and contain two boilers and two engines, forges, core ovens, ladles, saws, planer, sticker, mortiser, sand paper machine, etc.

The plant also includes frame store house, dry kiln, and a two-and-a-half storey warehouse and finishing department.
