

Peace and Security Competitions Fund

A quota of funds from the CIIPS annual budget is allocated by the Board of Directors to an independent Peace and Security Competitions Fund to support projects in two streams: research, and public discussion and information. The Fund is purely responsive in that the nature and subject matter of all proposals originates outside, although Fund staff are always available to advise on any aspect of an intended initiative or application at the planning stage.

The Fund is overseen by a seven member Council of Trustees composed of four Board members and three individuals from outside the Institute. Daily operations are the responsibility of the Fund Director who is also Secretary/Treasurer of the Institute.

Competitions for the quota of available funds are held semi-annually. All applications are reviewed by committees of advisors from outside the Institute. Their recommendations are then considered for decision by the Council.

In 1990/91, 134 applications for assistance were received resulting in 70 contributions totalling \$670,550. Successful applicants, projects and amounts were as follows:
