Sir,

I have the honour to refer to the Protocol Amending The Agreement between the Government of Japan and the Government of Canada for Cooperation in the Peaceful Uses of Atomic Energy, which was signed today, and to inform Your Excellency of the following:

It is the policy of the Government of Japan to take all possible measures to ensure that no source material or special nuclear material used or produced in a reactor together with identified material will be used for the manufacture of any nuclear weapons, the furtherance of any other military purpose or the manufacture of any other nuclear explosive device.
