

In keeping with our practice of commissioning papers from Canadian academics for the consideration of the Arms Control and Regional Security Working Group, Canada asked The Centre for Foreign Policy Studies at Dalhousie University, Halifax, Nova Scotia, to prepare two papers on Maritime CBMs. This paper is the second.
