His Excellency Habib Bourguiba, Junior, presented his Letters of Credence on April 18 as ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Tunisia to Canada. The ceremony took place at Government House at 11:00 a.m. The Chief of Protocol, Mr. Henry F. Davis, presented the Ambassador to His Excellency the Governor-General. Mr. G.P. de T. Glazebrook, Assistant Under-Secretary of State for External Affairs and Mr. Esmond Butler, Secretary to the Governor-General were in attendance on the Governor-General on this occasion.

Mr. Bourguiba, Junior, was born in 1927; he is the son of the President of Tunisia, has served recently as Tunisian ambassador to France and is presently Ambassador to the United States of America.
