Mr. Speaker informed the House that the Governor General in Council had appointed Thomas Russell Montgomery, Esquire, as Clerk Assistant of the House of Commons in the place of Edward Russell Hopkins, Esquire, who had resigned.

Mr. Howe, a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, laid before the House,—Copy of Order in Council P.C. 1234, approved March 3, 1952: Respecting the import of livestock, meat and meat products into Canada, and passed under the provisions of The Export and Import Permits Act and The Emergency Powers Act.
