- 2. This Act may be cited as the British North America Act, 1960, Short title and the British North America Acts, 1867 to 1952, and this Act may citation. be cited together as the British North America Acts, 1867 to 1960.
- 3. This Act shall come into force on the first day of September, Commence-nineteen hundred and sixty.

The Minister of Finance—On Monday next—In Committee of the Whole at the next sitting—The following proposed Resolution:—

Resolved, That it is expedient to introduce a measure to provide, by way of a guarantee for bank loans made before the 1st day of June, 1960, for short-term credit to grain producers in the Prairie Provinces to meet temporary financial difficulties arising from inability to thresh their grain; and to provide further that any amount paid to a bank under the Act shall be paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

Resolved, That it is expedient to introduce a measure to provide for the making of provisional payments to the producers for the 1959-60 crop year in respect of unthreshed grain in the designated area, as defined in the Canadian Wheat Board Act; and to provide for the costs, expenses and other financial obligations required in the making of such advances; such measure to include such further related and consequential provisions as are necessary to give effect to the foregoing.

Resolved, That it is expedient to introduce a measure to amend an Act to amend the Railway Act, chapter 40 of the Statutes of 1958, to permit certain grants to be made from the Railway Grade Crossing Fund for a further period of three years beyond January 31, 1961.

Resolved, That it is expedient to introduce a measure to amend the Department of Justice Act to provide for the appointment of two Associate Deputy Ministers of Justice.
