Of all the known materials, none excel Paraffine as a Waterproofer—and twenty years' exposure to the atmosphere does not alter its well-known qualities. Always works as soft as a glove on leather. DIRECTIONS FOR USE:—Have the boots clean and dry; apply heat to melt the Paraffine Dubbing; hold the boot before the fire and well warm the leather; rub with a rag a very small quantity of the melted Paraffine Dubbing, and toast it into the leather before the fire so as to soak it in the leather, but not too hot; and whilst warm, wipe off excess with a little paper;—will take the blacking at once.
