SYNOPSIS OF DOMINION LAND REGULATIONS

REGULATIONS ANY person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Mani-toba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, or certain con-ditions by father, mother, son, daugh-ter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

ter, brother or sister of intending homesteader. Duties—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

or sister. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section alongside his homestead. Price \$8.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside upon the home-stead or pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of home-stead entry (including the time re-quired to earn homestead patent) and cuttivate fifty acres extra.
