stranger dining with a member may be introduced by him to the billiard-room and be permitted to play at the tables on the day he shall have dined with such member.

Members may withdraw. ART. 18.—Any member whose dues are all paid shall be at liberty to withdraw from the Club, on his written application to that effect, sent in to the Committee, before the first stated annual meeting of the Club, to be held on the first Wednesday in April.

Expulsion of members.

ART. 19.—Any member wilfully infringing the constitution, or any of the Regulations of the Club, shall be liable to expulsion, by a vote of two-thirds of the Committee present at any meeting specially held for that purpose, reasonable notice of such meeting being previously given to such member.

Leaving, forfeit all claims.

ART. 20.—Any member who shall withdraw, resign, or be expelled, shall cease to be a member of the Club, and shall forfeit, ipso facto, all right or claim thereon, or in or to its property or funds; any member who shall be expelled shall forever thereafter be ineligible to be re-admitted a member of the Club.

Committee of management. ART. 21.—All the concerns of the Club shall be managed by a Committee to consist of twelve members, four of whom shall be elected annually by ballot, at the General Meeting of the Club, which shall be held on the first Wednesday in April in each year. And to that end the said Committee
