CONSTITUTION

OF THE

GRAND LODGE

OF THE

Ancient Order United Workmen of Ontario.

- 1. This Grand Lodge shall be known under the name, Title style and title of "The Grand Lodge of the Ancient Order of United Workmen of the Province of Ontario," and shall have jurisdiction over all Lodges and members of the Ancient Order United Workmen therein.
- 2. The Grand Lodge shall consist of its Grand Officers, Composition of Executive Committee, District Deputy Grand Masters, Grand Grand Medical Examiner, Grand Solicitor, and the Representatives Lodge of the Subordinate Lodges within the jurisdiction who have received the Grand Lodge Degree.
- 3. Grand Lodge shall have an official seal, with an appro-Seal priate device thereon.
- 4. All Past Master Workmen in good standing in their Rights of respective Subordinate Lodges, within the bounds of Grand P.M.W. as Lodge, shall be entitled to a seat, but without voice or vote, and all Past Master Workmen in good standing in other Grand Lodge jurisdictions, who have received the Grand Lodge Degree, may be admitted as visitors.
- 5. Each Subordinate Lodge shall be entitled to one representative, or one alternate who shall perform the duties of Grand representative in the case of the death, resignation or inability Lodge to serve of the representative, or of his inability to attend the
