Thus assuming the plan to be adopted for 100 families, and to be carried into effect in 1822, the advance of money must be made in the following manner:

It appears to the writer to be impossible, that upon equal capital any set of men of the class here contemplated, can be placed so advantageously in any other part of the world as in Upper Canada. The families will probably average three individuals and, able to work, and at the end of two years from their first
