Sir Howard Vincent Writes That the Cause is as Fresh as Ever.

PRESQOTT AND ITS OLD DRILL HALL.

Sentence of Murderer O'Brien Finally Approved of—A Wrong Man Arrested.

Ottawa, July 31.—A letter received from London, Eng., from Sir Howard Vincent, founder and hon. secretary of the United Empire League, declares emphatically that the division in the British Com-

mons on June 20 upon preferential trade was a farce, and did not represent the tide of popular feeling in favor of adequate reciprocity towards Canadian products.

He adds: "Let there be no misapprehension. The great cause is as fresh as ever, although it may have received a momentary check."

The letter also pays a tribute to Mr. A. McNeill, ex-M.P. for North Bruce, for the work he has done in Canada on behalf of preferential trade.

Liverpool Not So Good.

The Matthews Park Packing Co. of Ottawa, one of the largest in Canada, says that practically all the freight carried by the fast American line steamers from New York to Southampton consists of Canadian bacon. This is not, however, due to the superior speed of the American vessels, but to the superior dock arrangements at Southampton, which is cured lightly, and so has to be placed on the market without delay.

Hay for South Africa.

The Department of Agriculture will send 30,000 tons of hay to South Africa in August and 12,000 tons in September, making the 60,000 tons.

Highly Bidden.

An interesting incident occurred today in connection with the sale of an old drill hall at Prescott. The hall is owned by the Militia Department, and stands on property owned by the Department of the Interior. The sale has been advertised for five weeks, but to-day when it was to take place the militia department was refused to sign the sale.

The town was told it could get the hall if it was the highest bidder, and the town was getting a lease of the property on which it stands from the Interior Department.

O'Brien Will Hang.

The Governor-General has expressed his formal approval of the decision of the court that no reason has been shown why the death sentence on O'Brien, the Yukon murderer, should be interfered with.

The murderer will consequently be hanged on the date fixed for his execution. The conjecture that the reason for the hanging might be some difficulty in finding a properly qualified person in the Yukon country.
