

The errespondent saw among the prisoners men from Brest-Litovsk and Vilna, from the French front, and the garrisons of Hamburg, Bremen, Berlin, and Frankfort, from Hungary, Dalmatia and Bosnie, and they even included men from the 8th Austrian corps, now operating on the Isonzo front.

"According to reports circulated in Rumania." the correspondent continues, "the Austro German forces employed against Serbia number half a million, but the truth is that the Germans have been obliged to remedy the weakness of their infantry by powerful artillery abundantly supplied with munitions. They are able to advance into Serbia only by deluges of shells.

"Albania is causing anxiety, for the Germans have sent quantities of arms there and the Serbians have been obliged to keep an army of 6,000 on guard.

"General Radomir Putnik, the former Serbian minister of war, is suffering from asthma and the chief of the general staff, General Pavlovitch, is also ill. King Peter wished to go to the front, but the doctors forbade him to do so.
