

Toronto, Oct. 1-You do not get so

at the rate of six cents per pound the price is now seven cents.

Your dealer will tell you that he cannot help it at all. The wholesale price has been put up on him steadily for the past month and his sugar costs him about six dollars per hundred pounds exclusive of the cost of handling. At seven cents a pound he considers it a losing proposition, but then, the retailer never did reckon to make anything on sugar excepting that it is a commodity always in demand and it brings other trade in more profitable lines with it.

However, the housekeeper who is doing the late season preserving is much vexed about it. An advance of one cent per pound has upset her calculations. Home preserving is done on more generous lines as far as sugar is concerned than is done at the factories. With those people who have to count every cent it simply means they will use less sugar.


