Alfred Brown-That this Synod hereby records its conviction that the Church of Christ cannot, without guilt, acquiesce in the practical absence of religious instruction from the Public School system of this country, and feels that the circumstances of the times in which we live, and the manifest results of the purely secular system of education, call upon christian men to take action to remedy this evil. Be it therefore resolved that a committee be appointed to communicate and co-operate with the representatives of any religious bodies that may be disposed to co-operate in this object; and to take action should such co-operation not be secured, to devise a scheme for religious instruction
