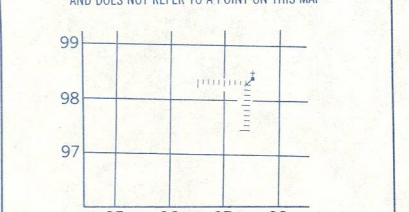

EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point	97

Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point		4
		984

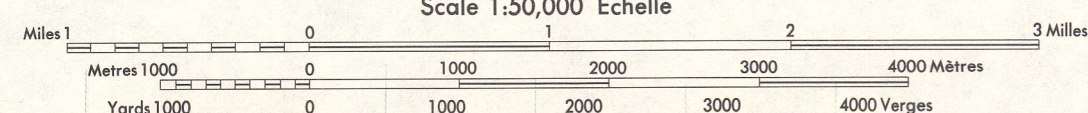
