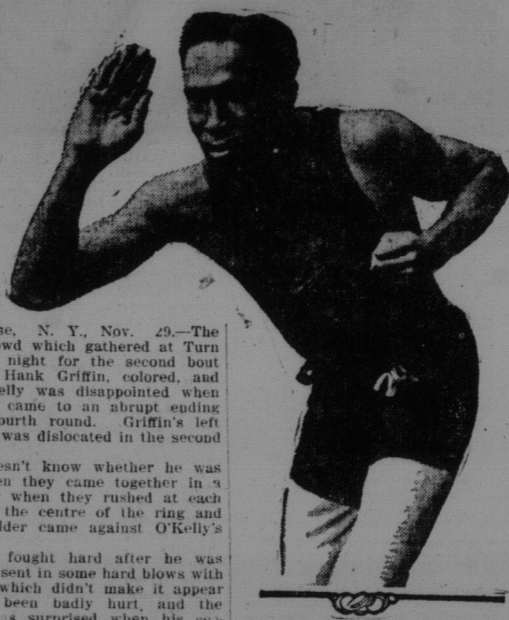
QUADRUPLE PLAY ONCE
