In case the conference is called as expected all governments of the world frespective of their being members or nonmembers of the league will be invited to send delegates.

Subjects that are likely to be considered at the proposed international gathering are: first, a revision if necessary of the agreement signed by the representatives of twenty-two nations at the conference of 1910, and second, passage of new legislation as the situation demands, and third, completion of the work begun at the conference of 1913, which remained unfinished because of the outbreak of the war.
