### CLOSED SEASON FOR SHAD

There was a time when the shad fishery was one of the important industries of our county. All along the Bay of Fundy ports and in the Basin of Minas large catches were obtained. Scotts Bay was an especially fine place for the catch. Now shad have almost left our waters and they have become an expensive luxury on our tables. It is now reported that in order to give time for restocking our waters with this fish a closed season for shad has been declared. Owing to the fact that investigation and reports have indicated that shad were becoming constantly scarcer, the Government in Feb. 28th last passed an order in-council as follows: That shad fishing in the Bay of Fundy waters is prohibited from the first of March, 1918, until the last of Feb., 1922.
