Eldest s. of the late Mr. John Mara, of Toronto, Ont. B. and Ed. there. Settled in B.C., 1862. M. Alice Telfer, only dau. of F. J. Barnard, Esq., ex-M.P. Is a merchant and a J. P. Sat in Leg. Assem. for Kootenay, from g.e. 1871 until g.e. 1875, when returned for Yale. Re-elected at g.e. 1878, and sat until the g.e. 1886, when he was not a candidate. First returned to the Commons at g.e. 1887, by acclamation. Was Speaker of the Leg. Assem. from 25 Jan., 1883, until the dissolution in 1886. A Conservative.—*Kamloops; Union Club, Victoria, B.C.*

MARSHALL, JOSEPH HENRY. (*East Middlesex.*)

Family, natives of Eng., resided in the Co. of Longford, Irel., for 15 years prior to settling in Canada. B. in London, Ont., 1854. Ed. at the Collegiate Institute and at Hellmuth, Coll. London. M. at London, Amy, only dau. of Richard Law Crump, of Algoa Bay, South Africa. Is a farmer. Has represented his Co. as Reeve and Warden for five years. First returned to Parlt. at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Cedar Terrace, London Tp., London, P.O.*

MASSON, JAMES, *Q.C.* (*North Grey.*)

S. of Thomas W. S. Masson, Esq., of Seymour, Co. of Northumberland, Ont., and grandson of Capt. Thomas Masson, R.A., whose residence was at St. Andrew's, Scot. B. in the Tp. of Seymour, Ont., 17 Feb., 1847. Ed. in the Common Sch. and at Belleville Grammar Sch. M., 29 July, 1873, Jessie, fourth dau. of Rev. D. Morrison, of Knox Church, Owen Sound. Called to the Bar, Ont., 1871, and apptd. Q.C., Oct. 1885. Was Master in Chancery at Owen Sound, from 1873 to Dec., 1885, when he resigned. First returned to Parlt. at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Owen Sound.*
