An Act to regulate the fees of Clerks of Justices of the Peace.

WHEREAS the fees allowed to Clerks of Justices of the Peace by the Act of Parliament of Lower Canada, 6 William IV., ch. 19, was inefficient and gave far more satisfaction to the public than the fees allowed under the present tariff; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows: Preamble.

I. The rates of fees allowed to Clerks of Justices of the Peace in the several Districts of Lower Canada, by any tariff or tariffs made by the Justices of the Peace in accordance with the provisions of Act 14 and 15 Vic., chap. 95, is hereby annulled, and the power to make the said tariff repealed; and the tariff fixed by the Act 6 William IV., chap. 19, shall be revived and come into force. Tariff of fees annulled.
