- IX. And be it further enacted, That if any person shall forge Penalty for 10 forging. any signature to any such certificate or extract, or shall tender in evidence any such certificate or extract knowing the signature thereto to be false and counterfeit, every such person shall be guilty of felony, and shall, upon conviction be punishable as in 15 the cases hereinbefore stated.
